"At nightfall weeping enters in, but with the dawn, rejoicing.

You changed my mourning into dancing; O Lord, my God, forever will I give you thanks." -Psalm 30:6cd, 12a, 13cd

By this Sunday, we may feel like the disciples in the Gospel. Even after the disciples met the Risen Christ (*twice!*), here they are experiencing a nightfall. Their joy has clearly dissipated, so they went back to fishing; and then to add insult to injury, they caught nothing. Surely there was some frustration and weeping involved here.

For us, the joy of Easter Sunday has probably waned. We pulled out all the stops for the Triduum, maybe even the Octave Day, but now we are likely back to a "normal" weekend. Maybe we are still burnt out from Triduum, or we are already tired from prepping for First Communions, upcoming wedding season, and Pentecost in a few weeks. And that's just at work! Home life may be tiring or hectic, too. In my case, our family is preparing for our fourth daughter to be born in just four weeks!

It's hard to be an Easter people. Nightfall's are a normal part of life even after experiencing the joy of the Risen Lord. The high points naturally wane to lows, and the lows can seem to last forever. But just when the night seems the darkest, dawn starts to break and the Light stands on the shore bringing rejoicing. We then can proclaim, "O Lord, my God, forever will I give you thanks."

Risen Lord,

as we continue to celebrate Your resurrection, be with us even when we experience nightfall's. In those times, help us always to seek You, the Light, which brings the dawn of a new day. Then, in the glorious light of Your presence, may we rejoice forever and give You thanks. Amen.


