The Wedding Ritual:

We ask God for strength and the saints for support in the wedding Mass. Left to our own devices, we fail. We need the grace of the Sacrament before we can begin this great endeavor. We need prayers to shore up the foundation of married life. Liturgy helps us do that.

Greeting the Couple at the Door

The priest, accompanied by the ministers, goes to the doors of the church where the wedding party is assembled. He greets the party joyously, then the entrance procession begins. The ministers go first. Then the parents & grandparents of the groom and bride. Then the attendants, and finally the couple. After that, the wedding Mass continues as normal.

This emphasizes the unity of the couple. We encourage all couples to use this entrance. It is the only option for cohabiting couples.

The Power of Music

We use Sacred Music for the Mass and for the Sacrament of Marriage. Secular music is designed to distract and to entertain. It is not designed to pull us out of ourselves or to focus us on Christ. Sacred music is designed to ask God for blessings and the saints for prayers.

Proper Staging helps us pray.

People want to be able to see the couple. People want to hear the vows. While we want cameras to record the event, we don't want people noticing the cameras. We want children in the ceremony, but they need to be old enough to understand their duties. The sanctuary space is not a platform. It is where heaven & earth meet. Only certain people are allowed in the sanctuary space at certain times for certain sacred duties.


